



CCA Designation Recognized by AIA, SIA and MIA

The CCA designation will be recognized by the three prairie province agrology institutes as follows:

A) New Applicants:

A maximum of 6 agrology credits (2 – 3 credit course equivalent value) will be allowed to count toward meeting the academic assessment standard of 60 agrology credits.

B) Request to Changing/Add to Area of Practice

Members registered to practice who do not have the formal education to support practice in crop management or related areas and who wish to practice in the area of Crop Science/Development/Agronomy will be granted recognition as follows:

A maximum of 6 agrology credits (2 – 3 credit course equivalent value) will be allowed to count toward meeting the practice area requirements. Each institute will manage their oversight of practice area management as guided by their respective institute registration protocols.

C) Continuing Competency:

Members may also use this designation and all related training and towards their continuing competency requirements in their respective provinces.
